SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

- Plays are to be sent via email as PDF attachments. Playwrights must use a pseudonym on the front page of their play so that the jury does not recognize their name.
- Please include a letter in the body of the e mail (that has the play attached) that outlines the history of the creation of this play. This letter should detail all related workshops/readings and dramaturgy. Playwrights must also include their real name and full contact information in this letter. For musical submissions, if there is a musical demo to be submitted, please do so via Dropbox link.
- Plays need to have numbered pages.
- Please send all play submissions to deannad@mnjcc.org.
- Please note, feedback on submitted plays is not part of this competition.

SUBMISSION FEE:

\$36 (+applicable taxes) in Canadian funds per play is to be paid with each submission. Payment can be made in 3 ways:

3. Paying with cash or debit in person (by July 5, 2017) at our lobby information desk, if you live in Toronto.

ELIGIBLE:

- Playwrights need not be Jewish but must be Canadian, or have a strong Canadian connection.
- Play content should have a Jewish focus, depicting a strong theme or aspect of Jewish life.
- Plays must be no less than one hour and no more than two hours in length.

INELIGIBLE:

- Plays that have been previously produced as a Canadian Actors' Equity Association co-op agreement or production agreement.
- Plays that have been previously produced outside of the CAEA agreements and staged for more than one
 week, with the exception of Fringe productions.
- Plays that have been submitted to the Canadian Jewish Playwriting Competition in the last ten years.

PRIZE:

- The MNjcc offers the winning playwright an 8-hour workshop with an Equity director and up to six Equity actors. This workshop concludes in a public staged play reading presentation.
- The winning playwright will receive \$1000.
- The winning play will be announced in January 2018.
- All eligible submissions are entitled to submit to the Jewish Plays Project's Jewish Playwriting Contest.
